Young ladies uniform will consist of:

Plaid skirt – skirt length must touch top of the knee.

Khaki or navy pants – must be purchased through uniform supplier.

Belt - a solid color black or brown belt must be worn with pants.

Shirt - white or light blue oxford cloth, button down collar. Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned.

white or navy golf shirts (long or short sleeved) with monogrammed OLL logo must be purchased through uniform supplier. Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned.

Socks – navy, black or white knee socks or tights, and/or natural nylons.

Shoes – black or brown dress shoes.

solid white or solid black tennis shoes with no other colors present.

all shoes **must have full backs** on them.

Sweater or Fleece - All students will be **required** to have a navy v-neck sweater or vest with OLL logo or half-zipper long sleeve fleece with school logo for Mass days.

Young men's uniform will consist of:

Khaki or navy pants – must be purchased through Schoolbelles. Slacks must be worn at the waist (i.e. above the hips).

Belt - a solid color black or brown belt must be worn with pants.

Shirt – white, light blue or blue striped oxford cloth, button down collar. Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned.

White or navy golf shirts (long or short sleeved) with monogrammed OLL logo must be purchased through Schoolbelles. Shirts must be tucked in and buttoned.

Socks – black, brown, navy or white.

Shoes – black or brown dress shoes.

solid white or solid black tennis shoes with no other colors present.

all shoes **must have full backs** on them.

Sweater or Fleece - All students will be **required** to have a navy v-neck sweater or vest with OLL logo or half-zipper long sleeve fleece with school logo for Mass days.

Tie - School tie is required on Mass day,

**On the day the high school attends Mass, students will be required to the regulation white, blue or striped oxford cloth shirt and the regulation navy OLL sweater or sweater vest. Boys are required to wear school tie on Mass day.

Special Dress Code Days:

Jeans Days: Students may dress casually, but appropriately, including jeans, tennis shoes, T-shirts, hooded sweatshirts, old Laker locker attire and/or athletic team shirts.

Warm Weather Code: Solid color T-shirts and shorts of any color. Tennis shoes and sandals with backs are permitted.

NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME (including special code days)

- Hats of any kind
- Hooded sweatshirts on dress code days
- Backless shoes: including flip-flops, athletic sandals . . .
- Large buckles on belts
- High-heeled shoes or boots
- Tank tops or tops with spaghetti straps
- Low-cut tops or anything immodest
- Earrings (or anything covering earrings) on males.
- Large earrings or large hoop earrings on young ladies. Jewelry needs to be limited to tasteful and discreet earrings and necklaces. **No choker style bands** may be worn around the neck.
- Hair with inappropriate color, length or styles.
- Girls are not permitted to wear large bands of any kind or hair wraps. They may wear barrettes, rubber bands or small ribbons.
- No excessive make-up.
- Boy's hair must be combed, above the collar and out of the eyes.
- Visible piercing with the exception of female ears.
- T-shirts with rock and roll groups, drug, alcohol, or sex logos. No shirt that displays words contrary to Christian values is permitted.
- Chains or spikes.
- Military clothing or boots
- Unshaven gentlemen
- Tattoos
- Inappropriate clothing (too tight, too long, too short, too revealing). Midriffs must be covered.
- Names may not be embroidered on any uniform pieces including sweaters.
- Athletic team shirts on game days.

The school administration reserves the right to determine the propriety of each student's style of dress and/or personal appearance. The administration also reserves the right to determine disciplinary action for dress code violations. Note: It is impossible for us to list all the articles of clothing/jewelry that cannot be worn. Please refer to what is permitted as part of the uniform.
